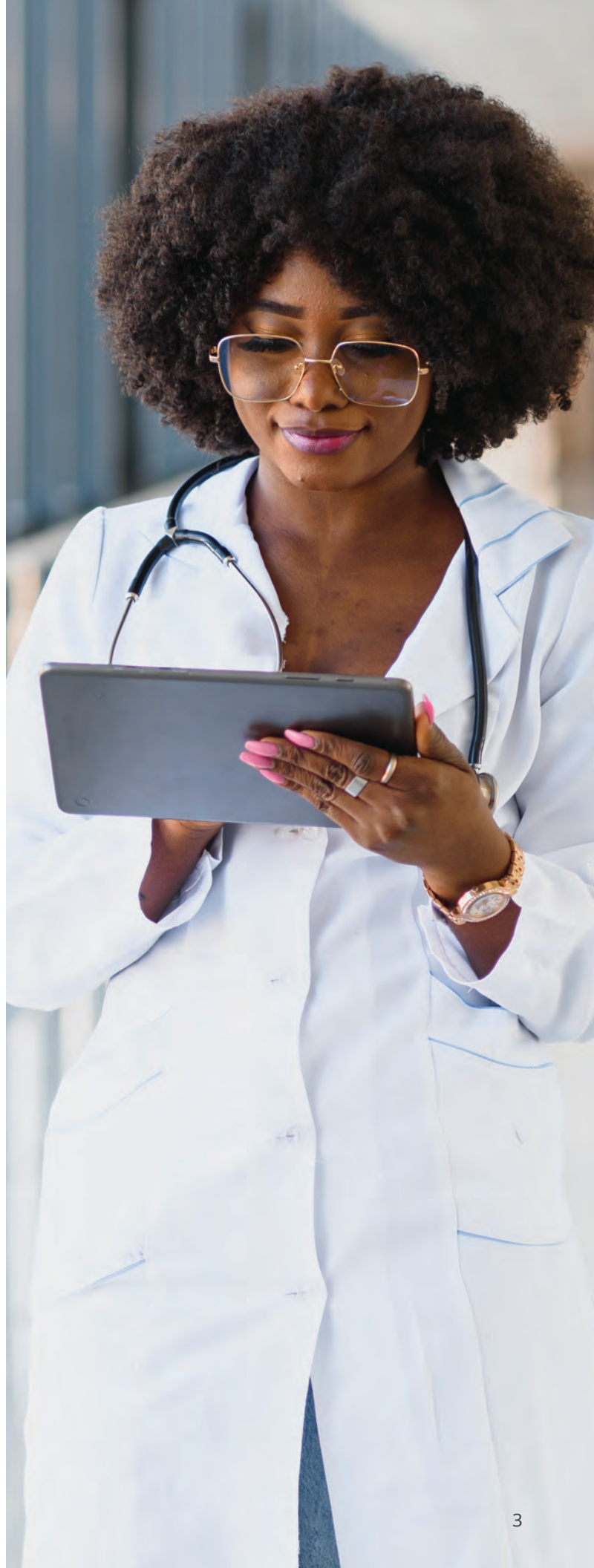
HEALWA IS PROUD TO PRESENT THE 2023 ANNUAL REPORT TO STAKEHOLDERS.

Washington is home to a diverse economy with a broad range of industries, including health care. Based on recent labor market analysis, it is estimated that employers will add 373,000 net new jobs in Washington state over the next five years. Most of these jobs — an estimated 70% — will require workers with a post-high school credential, such as a degree, apprenticeship, or certificate. HEALWA, the clinical library for Washington healthcare providers, serves 26 credentialed and licensed health professions including all acupuncturists, chiropractors, midwives, registered nurses, physician assistants, occupational therapists, speech language pathologists, and many more.

Next year, HEALWA will focus on access via a website redesign, health equity, and workforce development. HEALWA is renewing and energizing outreach efforts via strategic community partnerships with the University of Washington Government Relations Office of Spokane & Eastern Washington Relations. We must lead healthcare in Washington with safety and engagement and provide access to high quality clinical health information resources to improve patient outcomes and community health in Washington.

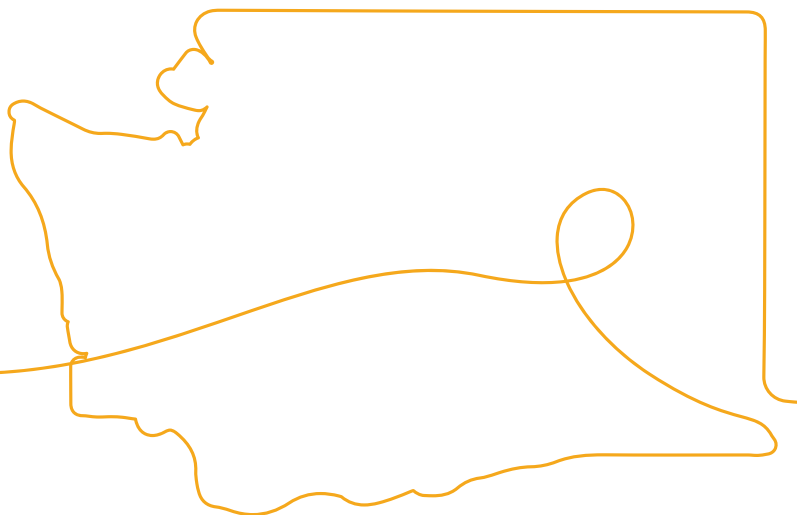
To be the provider of choice of current, authoritative clinical and educational information resources to every licensed healthcare provider in Washington State.

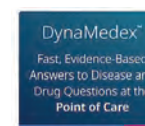
